

Last band concert set

Manhattan's Municipal Band Concert will be given this week on Monday evening at City Park Pavilion. This is the final band concert of the season and under the direction of its conductor Larry Norvell, the band will be repeating a number of favorites from its concerts earlier in the season, including *Lassus Trombone* and *America the Beautiful*. The soloists for this final concert will be Ron Menges, synthesizer, who will both present a demonstration of synthesizer music and will play *Chariots of Fire*, and drummers David Warner, Alan Keithly and Joe Burnett who will give a repeat performance of *The Horse — Drum War*.

On Tuesday evening the Clay Center Municipal Band, under the direction of C.L. Snodgrass, will play a concert in the Pavilion. The concert will feature a trumpet quartet which will perform *Four Heralds* by Eric Leidzen; *Thousand Hills Overture* by Claude Smith; *Shield of Freedom* by

Sammy Nestico and *New York, New York*.

There remain two other performances in Arts in the Park this season.

On Friday J.V. Heffel will play an organ concert and on Saturday evening the season will culminate in a concert by the nationally acclaimed rock group, Flash Cadillac.
