

Lecture recital slated by clarinetist Hasty

Nationally renowned clarinetist Stanley Hasty will be presenting a lecture recital and a seminar on clarinet technique in All Faiths on Thursday and Friday.

Mr. Hasty is currently professor of clarinet at the Eastman Rochester School of Music and he has had a varied career as a symphony player and soloist. He has played with the National Symphony, the Baltimore, Pittsburgh and the Cleveland Orchestras and can be heard playing the Charles Ives *Largo* on Vox recordings.

On Thursday at 8 p.m. Stanley Hasty will present a lecture recital on the Mozart *Clarinet Concerto*.

On Friday Mr. Hasty will conduct an all day seminar that commences

at 8:30 a.m. with a presentation on clarinet technique. At 9:30 a.m. he will audition soloists for a Symphonic Wind Ensemble concert and from 10 a.m. to noon he will conduct a master class.

Starting at 1 p.m., Mr. Hasty will be joined by Frank Sidorfsky for a seminar on reeds.

Tickets to the Thursday evening recital will be \$2 and admission to Friday's seminar will also be \$2.
