

Musical lineup note-able

The week's music events start out with the appearance of pianist Andre-Michel Schub in McCain Auditorium on Tuesday at 8 p.m. Mr. Schub soared into prominence in 1981 when he was declared the grand prize winner in the Van Cliburn International Piano Competition. His program will consist of *Sonata No. 12 in F Major, K.332* by Mozart, *Variations Serieuses, Op.54* by Mendelssohn, Robert Schumann's *Etudes Symphoniques, Op.13*, Beethoven's *Sonata No.11 in B-flat Major* and Franz Liszt's *Dante Sonata*.

On Wednesday evening at 8 in All Faiths, Jennifer Edwards, soprano, will present a recital that will include Henry Purcell's *Blessed Virgin's Expostulations*, a set of songs by Franz Schubert, *Una Voce Poco Fa*, from *The Barber of Seville* by Rossini, *Chansons Madecassas* by Ravel, a Missouri folksong, and mountain ballads by Clifford Shaw.

Of particular interest will be a performance of *Dejeuner sur l'herbe* by Texas composer Newel Kay Brown. Assisting Ms. Edwards for this work will be May Lee Cochran, flute, and Al Cochran, saxophone, in addition to Robert Edwards who will be the accompanying pianist for the other works. Warren Walker, cello, will be joining him and Mary Lee Cochran as well as Jennifer Edwards for the performance of *Chansons Madecassas*.

There will be a general student recital in All Faiths on Thursday at 11:30 a.m.

The Pablo Casals Trio will be performing as part of the continuing Chamber Music Series at 8 p.m. on Saturday, and the concert will consist of an all-Brahms program. The three trios to be performed span most of the composer's creative life, and each work, the Opus 8, 87 and 101 Piano Trios, are distinctive and characterful works.

Other music to be heard in town this week will include a return engagement for half of the former Rogers and Tinelli duo as Wally Rogers will be performing every evening at the Burgundy Lounge of the Holiday Inn. The group Main Street will be providing the music at Bockers II on Friday and Saturday evenings.
