

## Who dares wins

ST David's Hall, Cardiff, is about to have its own small contemporary music festival with a series of three concerts (two of which are part of the Contemporary Music Network) under the collective title of *Who Dares Wins*.

### Haunting

Steve Reich will be starting off this series with a performance of *Clapping Music* as part of the concert on Friday, February 7.

In addition to *Clapping Music* Steve Reich and musicians will be performing his *Drumming Part III, Sextet*, the haunting and fascinating *Vermont*

*Counterpoint* for live and taped flutes and *New York Counterpoint*.

The second concert in the series brings us closer to home with the London Sinfonietta performing the music of Takemitsu, Birtwistle and Weill on Tuesday, February 25.

The final concert in the series, on Tuesday, March 11, brings us right up to our own door step. It will be given by the St Donat's Music Theatre which will perform Stravinsky's *The Soldier's Tale*, a fable concerning a meeting with the Devil, and John Metcalf's *The Crossing* which centres on the German satiric artist, George Grosz.
